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Course structure

The programme is delivered in **two parts**:

Part A: Taught Component

Modules 1–4 (delivered through taught training)

- Legislative framework for SEND mediation
- Contextual knowledge of SEND
- Mediation practice and conduct of SEND cases
- Local processes and procedures

Part B: Professional Practice & Casework

Module 5 (practice-based)

- Observation of SEND mediations
- Co-mediation with experienced SEND mediators
- Lead mediator role in assessed cases
- Supported reflective practice and development planning
